Weston Park is accessed directly from the A5 at Weston-under-Lizard, just 30 minutes from central Birmingham, three miles off the M54 junction 3 and eight miles off the M6 junction 12.

Throughout 2019 we will be celebrating the 200th anniversary of the birth of Queen Victoria through the story of Victorian Weston.



The 3rd Earl of Bradford was Master of the Horse to Queen Victoria and made extensive alterations to the House during this period. He added the Orangery and a whole new wing to receive the many house party guests arriving by train to join the family for the weekend.

One of these guests was the Queen's favourite Prime Minister, Benjamin Disraeli, whose gift of a Yellow Parrot to Selina, Countess of Bradford still takes pride of place in the Drawing Room.

There's a wide range of opportunities to delve into these stories, go behind the scenes and see items of the collection from this era that have never been on display before.

Weston Park is owned and maintained by the Weston Park Foundation, an independent charitable trust which works to protect and maintain this beautiful estate.

Our 1767 Granary has a wide range of delicious dishes for you to enjoy with menus focused on local and seasonal ingredients. From award-winning coffee, freshly baked bread, homemade sandwiches and wholesome cakes to our signature Weston Burger there is something to tempt every taste.
