## Natural Rainbows

Make a rainbow using natural things you can find in the park, like flower petals, colourful bark, pebbles, sticks and leaves!

Make a giant rainbow with your findings in the grass somewhere in the park, so other visitors can find it.

## Bug Hunt

We're going on a bug hunt! Challenge yourself to see how many different creepy crawlies you can find in the woodland in 15 minutes.

Can you find a spider, an ant, a butterfly and a ladybird in the park today?

## Leaf Search

How many different leaves can you find on your walk around Weston? Can you match them to the trees in the woodland?

You can download the Woodland Trust's Tree Identification app to help you identify each species of tree that you find.

## Pollinator Survey

Carry out some science and geography fieldwork in the park. All you need is to bring some string along with you.

Measure out a 50cm x 50cm square containing some flowers like dandelions or buttercups. Record how many pollinators enter during a ten minute period.
