



## Dining Out with Us

Updated: Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September

We are thrilled to be able to welcome you back to the Granary. Whilst your dining experience may be a little different, we have a warm welcome and delicious food and drink on the menu.

We have been working closely with trade body UK Hospitality to ensure that we have all the measures in place to welcome you safely.

Recent government announcements are now legislation and written into law rather than guidance.

- We will not be accepting reservations for tables of more than 6 people
- Whilst we have been consistently taking contact details for the Governments Test & Trace policy we are now compelled by law to ensure that you leave your details with us. We advise that you download the NHS Test & Trace app before you visit and scan the QR code on your table.
- Our team will be wearing face coverings and we ask that you do the same when not seated at our table
- Whilst we strongly recommend that you make a reservation – we will be accepting walk-ups (if we have room) and will ask for contact details upon arrival
- We ask that you use the hand sanitiser available upon arrival
- Our tables will be sufficiently spaced out to ensure the required social distancing
- Your order will be taken at your table and we will be discarding printed menus after every use
- As you would expect, exacting standards of hygiene will be applied throughout the Brasserie from regular toilet cleaning through to the kitchen; all our team will be routinely washing their hands, sanitising work stations and public areas and wearing face masks and gloves where appropriate

- Under current legislation we can only welcome tables of up to 6 people. You will not be able to make a reservation from groups larger than 6 people.
- We ask you to maintain social distancing at all times with diners that are not in your party
