Purpose of Role:

Weston Park's Granary Art Gallery opened in 2009 following the conversion of the 18th Century Granary building with support from the Heritage Lottery Fund. This beautiful new space features monthly selling art exhibitions from contemporary artists around the country, as well as displaying a handful of historic paintings on loan to Weston Park from private collections. The Art Gallery plays an important role in supporting the charitable aims of the organisation, as all commission received from sold works goes towards providing materials for more than 6000 school children who visit Weston Park every year. We are looking for Volunteers to work within the Gallery, to assist visitors and sell works.

Main Responsibilities:

- To welcome visitors who are visiting the Art Gallery
- To provide information about Weston Park, current and future exhibitions in the Gallery
- To assist customers choosing to buy pieces and process any sales
- To make sure works are safe, responding calmly and professionally to any unexpected issues that may arise.
- To be clean and enthusiastic, dressing appropriately
- To assist at Gallery private view events, welcoming guests and promoting the artists work
- To be positive about all exhibitions irrespective of personal likes or dislikes
